## **Matt plastic paint**

#### **DESCRIPTION**

A well-covering matt plastic paint, made with polymerised acrylic styrene resins in water dispersion. It is completely water resistant, rain impermeable and vapour permeable, resisting erosion and wearing even in the most aggressive of environments. Indicated for the protection of exteriors, home interiors and commercial premises.

### **APPLICATION METHODS**

Stir the contents of the container well until a consistent blend is achieved.

Eliminate dust, grease, saltpetre and other imperfections in bad condition.

Apply with a brush or roller depending on the practicalities of each case.

On new mortar or plaster surfaces, apply two coats: the first diluted by 15% and the second by 8% maximum.

On old painted surfaces, scrape off and completely remove flakes and badly sticking areas then proceed as for new surfaces.
